

## Fourth Degree Exempt at St. Patrick-St. Anthony's in October 2023

Brother first and second- and thirddegree knights. This coming October there will be a fourth-degree exemplification held at St. Patrick – St. Anthony's parish.

This would be an opportune time for you to prepare for advancement into our order's highest degree, Fourth Degree also known as the Patriotic Degree.

To qualify you must be a third degree in good standing. For first- and second-degree members to advance to third degree is easy. Sign up for the first-degree exempt get through this event, usually after the last Sunday mass of the month, about an hour at most. You will have advanced to the third degree. We have also done these at the Council before regular meetings. I will have more info soon. If you can't wait, contact our district deputy, his info is on the back page.

In 2022, we continued our long-standing commitment to our parish ministries and our primary fundraising activities, Weekly Bingo, Lenten Fish Frys, and the Tootsie Roll Drive. As a result, we have made a significant positive impact in two key areas in our community, supporting both Pro-Life activities and Special Needs People in our community through our support for **Positive Options** and for **Area 12 Special Olympics**. The support we provide for these two activities is truly a manifestation of God's presence here in Ottawa County.

There is, however, some disappointing news. In 2023, K of C Council 2975 has decided to suspend our annual Lenten Fish Frys. Although Fish Frys are a staple of Catholic activity during the Lenten Season, the lack of available fish and increasing prices for foods and sundries needed to conduct the Fish Frys drove the decision. The Lenten Fish Frys have not been an effective fundraiser for several years now. We will review the possibility of reinstating Fish Frys for the 2024 Lenten Season.

Lastly, I ask that you prayerfully consider increasing your level of support for the activities of our council by volunteering to work Van Andel Arena concessions, if possible. By increasing the amount of your time & talents that support local K of C activities here at Council 2975, you can help us maintain & expand how we live our faith through action.

Brother Knights, we have a wonderful Fundraising Opportunity with Van Andel Arena. Historically, there have been 20-30 charitable groups that have served in the concession venues at Van Andel Arena in Grand Rapids. Today, there are only 6 groups serving during hockey games and various concerts. Note: Elton John, Doobie Brothers, REO Speedwagon, Styx, etc. are all scheduled over the coming months. We have been invited to provide 2-10 volunteers to serve food and drinks at the concession stands. This may involve some limited cooking, cutting pizzas, running a cash register, etc. We would receive a percentage of the sales (8-10%) with guaranteed minimums. We've been advised that we could make \$300 - \$1000 per night. Shifts are generally

~5 hours of work on your feet. A representative from Van Andel presented at our Membership Meeting in December and described the "fun" she's had doing this work while fundraising.
